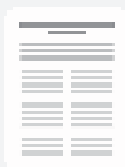


CALL FOR PAPERS

Deadline for Funding: 31 July 2024 | General Deadline: 16 September 2024

The CSAE Conference 2025 is now inviting submissions relevant to issues of development economics in Africa.*

The conference will take place from 23-25 March 2025 at St Catherine's College in Oxford, UK, and will feature a keynote, panels, and sessions from a range of development economics topics.



HOW TO SUBMIT

To submit a paper for consideration you must complete the submission form by 16 September 2024.

NEW THIS YEAR: Applications for funding must be submitted by 31 July 2024.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Only FULL DRAFTS of papers will be considered.
- You are required to submit an abstract for your paper.
- Authors can ONLY SUBMIT ONE PAPER.
- Papers must be submitted and presented in English.

*Papers discussing countries other than those in Africa will be considered provided they deal with issues central to development economics in Africa.

If awarded, funded participants will attend both a pre-conference workshop from 03-06 December 2024, in Pretoria South Africa, and the CSAE Conference from 23-25 March 2025 in Oxford, UK. Funding will cover flights, accommodation, catering, and conference registration costs.
