The CSAE Speaker Hub is an online portal for all speakers to log in, view their session information, update their profile, and view their speaker tasks. Find out how to access the CSAE Speaker Hub by following the instructions below.



Go to the CSAE Speaker Hub portal (<u>https://cvent.me/10Dqdo</u>) and press the Log In button

Enter your first name, last name, and email address. Please use the email address that you used for your submission on the CSAE Conference 2023 Submissions website.



The verification code box will now appear. Please check your email inbox for your unique verification code email. This can take a few minutes to appear. Enter the six-digit verification code into the box and then click verify.



The email will look like this (but your version will include a code):

Once you have entered the code, you will be logged into the CSAE Speaker Hub. You can navigate the Hub by the tabs at the top. Choose from:

- My Session (your session date, time, and description)
- My Profile (edit your speaker profile)
- Session Guidance (view the session format and roles)
- My Tasks (each speaker has tasks to complete)
